We strive to offer, at no cost to you and your students, enriching programs in Holocaust/genocide/human rights education. We would like to continue to offer free programming, but we can only do so with your help. Your membership to HGHREC will directly fund the programs that we bring to you and your students. Our special *Teacher's Membership* offer initiated last year met with great success so we are pleased to continue it for 2009-2010. Not only will it enable you to support our programming, but the *Teacher's Membership* enables us to provide you in return with some of the resources we have produced here at HGHREC.

Our *Teacher's Membership* follows the same fee schedule as our regular memberships. However, for your fee, you will receive the following gifts:

- **\$36.00 Membership** includes a DVD of our film *Soulsaving: Common Threads of Kindness*. This film, co-produced and directed by filmmaker Isaak Dostis, looks at singular acts of kindness that changed survivors' lives allowing them to survive another moment and more during the Holocaust. This excellent teaching tool focuses on rescue and comes with a curricular packet for grades 6-12 designed specifically for the film by Jane Denny, HGHREC's Director of Education.
- **\$54.00 Membership** includes the DVD of our film *Soulsaving: Common Threads of Kindness* and our book *To Tomorrow's Children*. This book features the photographs and essays of 29 local Holocaust survivors. They poignantly recall a focal point in their Holocaust experience, closing with a message that is a legacy for the children of tomorrow. The book includes a companion timeline that lists key events during the period, both historical and in the lives of the survivors.
- **\$100.00 Membership** includes a *Holocaust, Genocide & Human Rights Education Center* Tote Bag packed with the DVD of our film *Soulsaving: Common Threads of Kindness*, our book *To Tomorrow's Children*, and our newest publication, *A Tribute to*

Holocaust Survivors in our Community. In this book, more than 130 local Holocaust survivors have shared photographs of their life before the war and the life they created here post-war, a list of their Holocaust experience and a personal message to the reader.

This book features readings from the works of leading scholars in the field of Holocaust studies, and covers the entire narrative from the history of anti-Judaism and antisemitism to the post-Holocaust world. The book also provides substantial coverage of rescue, including profiles of rescuers, and features rare photographs and other visuals.
- **\$1800.00 Life Membership** (payable over five years at \$360 per year) includes all of the above and a guaranteed seat at our acclaimed *Summer Fellowship Institute for Teaching the Holocaust, Genocides, and Human Rights Issues*, **for free**. This 2-week comprehensive training is appropriate for middle and high school teachers, administrators and professional staff. Participants in this Fellowship Institute will learn techniques and strategies to address these topics. A three-day museum studies program includes trips to the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum in Washington, D. C. and The Museum of Jewish Heritage: A Memorial to the Holocaust in New York City. In addition to the pedagogical training and materials that this level of membership provides, it demonstrates your life-long commitment to Holocaust, genocide and human rights studies for our children. **This life membership is available for schools and other educational institutions as well as for individuals.**
